

**ADMINISTRATIVE COMMISSION REPORT TO PRESBYTERY**  
**First Presbyterian Church, Kansas City, Kansas**

The Administrative Commission assigned to First Presbyterian Church, Kansas City, Kansas, participated extensively at the last meeting of Presbytery in leading the celebration of this congregation's life and ministry. The Presbytery voted to dissolve the congregation effective June 2, 2010.

At present, the church property is once again under contract for sale to Mt. Sinai Missionary Baptist Church with a closing date on or before June 1, 2010. Our Commission continues to meet regularly with the Session as it concludes such tasks as the sale and distribution of property items, final decisions concerning assets and liabilities, continuing management of the property and negotiations with its renter, Head Start, and plans for concluding the sale. Plans are underway for the legal dissolution of the corporation. We believe that the Session will complete all remaining tasks by the dissolution date set by the Presbytery.

Facing continuing uncertainty as to whether the sale of the property will actually occur, the Commission encouraged the Session to meet with representatives of the Business Affairs Committee and of the Trustees of the Presbytery. Through these agents, the Presbytery is prepared to assist the Session in various ways and to receive both the assets and the liabilities of the congregation on June 2.

If there is no sale, the Presbytery will immediately assume ownership and management of the property; if the sale occurs, the Presbytery will receive the proceeds and manage them in light of previous agreement with the Session.

This Commission will continue to meet with the Session and assist in the completion of the Session's final responsibilities.
