## “Hands-On” Mission Projects

We have heard some Presbyterian Women say, “Let’s stop sitting on our hands and DO SOMETHING!?” So two years ago, the PWs of each of the presbyteries in our synod agreed to co-sponsor a hands-on “Mission-N-A-Weekend.” In Heartland, we have planned a 2-project, 2-day challenge, which includes both an urban (Harvesters) and a non-urban (Heartland Presbyterian Camp & Conference Center) hands-on project, both of which serve people of the entire Kansas City metro area. People are welcome to participate in either or both projects, and we are hoping for at least a dozen volunteers from outside the metro who want to know more about feeding the hungry and feeding the spirit.

Each project can accommodate 120 volunteers.

Each adult volunteer is asked to pay \$10 to help defray meal and projects expenses. (Children and teens are SO welcome that they are free!) Any income that exceeds our expenses will go to Harvesters and Heartland Presbyterian Center.
