Harold Thomas Center and LAMP are a physical reminder of the Presbytery's commitment to our neighbors in urban Kansas City. Heartland is one of just a few Presbyteries that has continued to be intentional in its urban presence.

Heartland Presbytery Center continues to be a vital resource to congregations and the community, providing meeting and retreat space and engaging children and adults in worship, education and mission opportunities in its summer camps and year round activities.

Congregational Development and Redevelopment will be able to continue to support New Church development while it continues its work aiding existing congregations with redevelopment efforts.

The **Mission Outreach and Social Justice Division** provides funding for the St. Joseph Interfaith community, community mission work and our brothers and sisters in Guatemala through the International Partnership.

The **Presbyterian Urban Network Ministry** provides much needed support and programming to the congregations doing ministry and outreach in urban areas.

Worship and Fellowship plans and implements worship at each meeting of Heartland Presbytery.

Stewardship and Mission Interpretation Division provides resources and materials for congregational stewardship campaigns and necessary communication and interpretation of Heartland's budget needs and mission plans.

Mission Personnel includes salaries and compensation for staff members directly involved in doing the mission of Heartland Presbytery including the Associate Executive Presbyter, Community Outreach Coordinator and their mission support staff.
