The Position and Policy of our Presbyterian
Church USA (1994)*

Our reformed theology...proclaims a Christian responsibility for health that is personal and public. The latter includes acting in the public realm to assure the availability of health-giving resources to all people. Therefore...universal coverage is to be commended and congress should be urged to enact legislation that will provide guaranteed coverage for all.

The General Assembly of the Presbyterian Church (USA) has encouraged all its members to engage in advocacy for universal health coverage as a normative part of their stewardship commitment, and to work with the Administration and Congress for a compassionate and just national health care system.
